Dale Sells motioned accept the proposed motion to impose a \$1,000 fine on P-4, 16, 23, 27, 28, and P-29 for the resident's use of the WCA facilities to be suspended, with enforcement suspended and the fines subsequently waived provided the violation does not reoccur within the next 3 months (thru 05/12/2022). > 30 Year Anniversary Celebration

The Westchase Board discussed the WCA 30-year anniversary celebration with a goal of April/May for an event. Shawn will reach out to the attorney for Maloney's regarding use of the area at Maloney's and Jim will contact Maloney's directly for recommendations for vendors to use. Proposing on having food trucks, music and activities for all ages and to have the road in front of Maloney's blocked off from vehicular use for safety reasons.
