Joaquin Arrillaga motioned to approve the consent agenda items: Aug 11, 2022 Board minutes and Acme Movies contract for Oct 2022 - Mar 2023. Keith Heinemann seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 6-0

• Second Notice of Violations with Proposed Fine

Dale Sells motioned to accept the proposed motion to <u>**not**</u> impose a fine on P-1, 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 12 and P-14. Eric Holt seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 5-0

Dale Sells motioned to accept the proposed motion to impose a \$1,000 fine on P-2, 3, 6 and P-9 for the resident's use of the WCA facilities to be suspended, with enforcement suspended and the fines subsequently waived provided the violation does not reoccur within the next 3 months (thru 12/08/2022). Eric Holt seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 5-0

Dale Sells motioned to impose a \$1,000 fine on P-7 and for the resident's use of the WCA facilities to be suspended for a maximum of 90 days, with the first day of suspension being the fifth day after confirmation by the Covenant Committee. Eric Holt seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 5-0

Pipeline – Renewal Contract 2023 Rate Increase

Eric Holt motioned to increase the Pipeline monthly fee by 10% (\$94.50)f or the January 1, 2023 renewal. Joaquin Arrillaga seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion failed 3-3 (Dale, Keith, Shawn)

Dale Sells motioned to increase the Pipeline monthly fee to \$1,000 for the January 1, 2023 renewal. Shawn Yesner seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion failed 3-3 (Eric, Joaquin, Jim)

Joaquin Arrillaga motioned to increase the Pipeline monthly fee to \$1,025 for the January 1, 2023 renewal. Eric Holt seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 6-0
