# > AB Tennis Contract - Tennis Camp - Amend Section 5

Section 5 of the current AB Tennis contract requires all coaches, instructors, employees, contractors and agents who interact with participants in the tennis program be certified and be required to attend continuing education and coaching clinics. Coach Alex is asking for the certification requirement to be waived for his summer tennis camp counselors as they will only be part time summer workers helping with the children during camp.

Joaquin Arrillaga motioned to waive the certification requirement as noted in Section 5 of the AB Tennis Contract for his tennis camp counselors. Jim Brinker seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 7-0

# **Pipeline Proposed Contract Amendments**

Proposal#1 – change item#5 summer swim team hours from 7am-11am to reflect 4:30pm-7:30pm to allow working parents to keep their children in the swim program

Dale Sells motioned change item#5 in the Pipeline Contract for the summer swim team hours for Mon-Fri to be 4:30pm-7:30pm and keep Saturdays at 7am-11am. Jim Brinker seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 6-1 (joaquin)

Proposal#2 – for Pipeline coach to lifeguard at no cost to the HOA during the 5am-8am Mon-Wed-Fri early bird swim hours.

Eric Holt motioned to deny Pipeline second proposal regarding the 5am-8am swim hours. Jim Brinker seconded the motion. Vote was taken and the motion carried 7-0
